#### **Miss Contestants**

- Must be 17 years of age and no older than 23 by January 1, 2014;
- Must never have been married or have had a child;
- Must be a resident of and live in Louisiana;

#### **Teen Miss Contestants**

- Must be 14 years of age and no older than 16 by September 8, 2013;
- Must never have been married or have had a child;
- Must be a resident of and live in Louisiana

#### **Junior Miss Contestants**

- Must be 10 years of age and no older than 13 by September 8, 2013;
- Must never have had a child;
- Must be a resident of and live in Louisiana

#### **Deb Miss Contestants**

- Must be 8 years of age and no older than 9 by September 8, 2013
- Must be a resident of and live in Louisiana

# The contestants will be scored in the following categories:

- 3-5 minute Interview (Miss)— Suit or Sunday Dress
- 30 second Introduction (ALL) Blue Jeans and White Button down shirt
- <u>Evening Gown</u> (ALL) Full length formal, color of your choice

In the event of 10 or more contestants we will name a Top 5, and they will compete in On Stage Question.

### **Contestant Rules & Regulations**

- 1) All contestants are expected to attend ALL events designated for their competition group (see agenda). Any contestant who is unable to attend an event, must have approval of director prior to the competition date;
- 2) Contestant must be a naturally born female. Contestants in ALL divisions must be never married/have had a child.
- 3) Please be aware that the judges will be given the same information as the contestants, and are encouraged to select the girl who will make the best Queen. If you feel you cannot commit yourself to the responsibilities of being our Queen, please refrain from competing. Once your application is received, you will be sent the same set of guidelines our judges are given, and festival information. Should you enter late this will effect you receiving this information.
- 4) Contestants are allowed two (2) Guests during the day activities. NO EXCEPTIONS! Please do not invite your significant other to spend the day with you. No cell phones allowed backstage; No one will be allowed backstage with you including, but not limited to: fathers, mothers, sisters, brothers, friends, and hairdressers. Please advise your guests: Door admission is \$5.00; EVERYONE MUST PAY. Poor sportsmanship is NOT tolerated. Those involved will be escorted out.
- 5) Please be on time for all events and call Carrie Gagliano (225) 715-9120 if you will be late for any portion of the competition. At no time will the pageant be delayed due to the tardiness of a contestant. If you are more than 5 minutes late, and you have not called, we will not wait for you and the judges will be aware of your tardiness. You will also have 2 points deducted from your total score each time you are late for an event;
- 6) All parents and/or guests of the contestants are responsible for their own accommodations and food. Contestants are responsible for any overnight accommodations they may require; however, space for preparation will be provided.
- 7) A copy of your score sheet is \$5.00, and scores will be mailed to contestants who turn in a self addressed stamped envelope with their applications. Scores will NOT be emailed;
- 8) Should a contestant decide not to compete, or is deemed ineligible after she has paid her entry, her money will not be refunded.
- 9) A contestant may not hold a binding or festival title at the time of the competition. If a contestant holds any non-binding or non-festival title, she agrees that her first obligation is to the City of Baker and the Baker Buffalo Festival for appearances. If it is discovered that a contestant holds another binding or festival title, she will forfeit her eligibility to compete; if a contestant has previously held a binding or festival title she must remain in good standing with her past organization(s).
- 10) . Contestants under the age of eighteen (18) MUST have a parent/guardian present at the mandatory orientation prior to competition;
- 11) The official queen's contract will be signed after the winners are crowned that evening.

## What is expected of a Baker Buffalo Festival Rose Queen?

- Queens are required to maintain lady-like behavior when representing the Baker Buffalo Festival and City of Baker. This includes on Facebook, MySpace, Etc...
- To maintain contact with the Pageant Director. This includes any questions regarding contracts, events, or any other situation that may arise.
- To maintain satisfactory academic marks. We take pride in the achievements of our queen.
- To remain unmarried and without child. Failure to do so results in automatic resignation of title.
- To abide by all rules set forth in the contract signed upon winning. MISS QUEEN MAY NOT COMPETE FOR ANY OTHER TITLE UNTIL AFTER CROWNING A SUCCESSOR THE FOLLOWING YEAR.
- To travel on the weekends to other festivals/ festival pageants, and to attend mandatory City of Baker events. Miss is required to attend 15 events throughout the year. Teen/Junior/Deb queens are not required to travel. However, they must sign a contract outlining expectations in the event they do attend an event on behalf of the Baker Buffalo Festival.
- To have fun, make friends, and to become a part of the Baker Buffalo Festival Pageant family.
